"Creativity and Cooperation in the South Eastern Baltic Area" June 7-8, 2013 Kaliningrad

INVITATION

The initiative of Modernization of the South Eastern Baltic Area through regional cooperation (SEBA), was launched by the Council of the Baltic Sea States in the summer of 2011. Two years later, in June 2013, a conference addressing creativity and human potential of the SEBA area will be held in Kaliningrad.

The Council of the Baltic Sea States would therefore like to invite you to participate in this event.

There will be four sessions with the special focus on the South Eastern Baltic Area during the first day of the conference: "Sustainable tourism: potential for international partnerships", "Cooperation in the field of arts, culture and creative industries: key policies, challenges and potential synergies", "Architectural heritage: integration into the modern urban landscapes", "University Networking for Quality and Development". Among others, newly developed projects and initiatives will be presented, such as the trans-border cooperation in the natural park *Lake Vistynets (Vistytis)/ Rominten Forest* and *Balticlab*, a project development programme empowering creativity and entrepreneurship in the region. Key aspects of the plenary are also focused on searching for common ground between Russia and the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR).

The enriched cultural and creative programme is integrated into the conference. In the evening on the 7th June, the participants are invited to enjoy a special musical and art event *The Spirits of the Baltic,* held at the newly restored historical site of Königsberg, visited by Peter the Great – Friedrichsburger Gate. On the 8th June you are welcome to explore the magnificent area of the Rominten Forest and Vistynets lake.
