- Joint Selection Commission
 (Rossotrudnichestvo + foreign national authorities + embassy);
- Commission determines the selection procedure;
- Candidates choose no more than 6 Russian HEIs.

Step 2. Selection of candidates by Russian HEIs.

Direction 1. Fixed Planning:

- Networking universities
- Eurofaculty-Pskov Project
- Slavic universities
- Universities that have obligations according to the international agreements;
- State-private partnership, etc.

Direction 2. Competition among Russian HEIs:

 HEIs determine countries and selection procedures




